Task 1: Status Update on Credit Development















Batch 1 Practices

Infiltration devices and filter strips

- Credit documents have been submitted to technical workgroup in mid October (agency staff and Subject Matter Experts (SMEs))
- After feedback is received, documents will be revised and distributed to wider review group in November (NSAB, WOC, PFC)

Soil amendment

- Drafted the technical support document for review by the SMEs (Deanna Osmond and Rich McLaughlin) and agency staff and met on October 28th to discuss
- Narrowed down the potential methods and will revise technical document for review by SMEs prior to drafting the credit document













Batch 2 Practices

- Land conservation
 - Received feedback from SMEs at NCSU in mid October
 - Distributed technical document to technical workgroup
 - Scheduling a meeting in December to discuss practice
- Pervious area nutrient management and bioretention
 - Awaiting feedback from SMEs













Batch 3 Practices

Livestock exclusion

- Drafted the technical document for review by the SMEs
 (Deanna Osmond and Dan Line) and agency staff; met on Oct. 28th
- Approach was generally accepted; need to revise studies
- Additional meetings will be required to address implementation issues, particularly double counting

Elimination of illicit discharges

Awaiting local data from the City of Durham

Riparian buffers

- Reviewing literature to inform development of this practice
- Postponed meeting with technical workgroup to allow for review of Permanent Buffer Mitigation Rule and HB 44
