## Interim Report

- E-mailed to PFC on Thursday, October 29, 2015
- Covers period through June 2015 (FY2015)
- Purpose
  - Review monitoring program status and data collection efforts
    - Routine Monitoring
    - Special Studies
  - Provide a preliminary exploration of the data
  - With 11 months of data it is premature to draw extensive conclusions
- Focuses on tributary data; lake data will be included in annual report





### **Routine Monitoring**

- Repeated testing of water quality at <u>fixed locations</u>.
- Provide <u>insight</u> into <u>seasonal and spatial variation</u> of nitrogen, phosphorus, and other parameters.
- Provide <u>data</u> for <u>water quality models</u>.

### **Special Studies**

 Focused data collection efforts to inform water quality modeling to more accurately simulate baseline and management scenarios













#### 468 sampling attempts between August 2014 and June 2015

- 6% of attempts occurred when there was <u>no water</u>, <u>no flow</u>, or <u>not enough water</u>
- < 2% prevented by road or bridge <u>construction</u>
- < 2% prevented by <u>ice storms</u> despite multiple attempts over several days (February).







