#### **Agenda Review/Revisions**

#### **Potential Core Principles**

- Proceed with a proposal only if there is consensus among members
- An alternate framework would require jurisdictional participation
- Project-based or investment-based framework
  - Must be fair and equitable
  - Would replace current rule requirements and provide a bridge to the completion of the reexamination process
- Cost efficiencies would be considered
  - Pooling resources
  - Transport factors/proximity to the lake
  - Potential use of specific jurisdictions' staff resources to undertake joint projects

#### **Potential Core Principles, Continued**

- All projects accounted for under the "bridge" framework would be counted as part of the revised re-examination strategy
  - Projects already completed since 2006
  - Projects completed after establishing the "bridge" framework
- Additional projects (above and beyond those agreed-to under the bridge framework) will also be accounted for under the future revised strategy developed by the reexamination process

# Tracking Information: Potential Approaches, Methods, and Considerations

- Increases in impervious area, 2006 2012, based on USGS impervious surface dataset
- Determine how to factor in water users, relative benefits, and fair assignments under the bridge framework
- UNRBA fee framework
  - As is, or
  - Modified based on increase in impervious area
- Consider resources available to develop and manage the analysis
- Provide for relative assignments based on impacts and limiting resources
